Notes

In terms of taxonomy and scientific nomenclature, the BB list follows the International Ornithological Union's IOC World Bird List (<http://www.worldbirdnames.org/>). The English names used are broadly the same as those used in previous versions of the BB list. In most cases these are the same as the international English names used in the IOC World Bird List, but in some cases more familiar European names are retained (for example, divers and skuas rather than loons and jaegers). Separate columns in the BB list denote differences in English names from the IOC World Bird List and also from the vernacular names used by the British Ornithologists' Union in the official British List (<https://www.bou.org.uk/british-list/>).

Status of birds in Great Britain

The categories of the British List are defined as follows:

A	Species that have been recorded in an apparently natural state at least once since 1st January 1950.
B	Species that were recorded in an apparently natural state at least once between 1st January 1800 and 31st December 1949 but have not been recorded subsequently.
C	Species that, although introduced, now derive from the resulting self-sustaining populations.
C1	Naturalised introduced species - species that have occurred only as a result of introduction, e.g. Little Owl <i>Athene noctua</i> .
C2	Naturalised established species - species with established populations resulting from introduction by man, but which also occur in an apparently natural state, e.g. Greylag Goose <i>Anser anser</i> .
C3	Naturalised re-established species - species with populations successfully re-established by man in areas of former occurrence, e.g. Red Kite <i>Milvus milvus</i> .
C4	Naturalised feral species - domesticated species with populations established in the wild, e.g. Rock Dove/Feral Pigeon <i>Columba livia</i> .
C5	Vagrant naturalised species - species from established naturalised populations abroad, e.g. Sacred Ibis <i>Threskiornis aethiopicus</i> from the naturalised French populations.
C5.1	Vagrant from re-established population – individuals from population established from conservation translocation(s) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - in order to re-establish a species within its former range but for which there is no evidence of Britain being part of its - former range. Currently, there are no species in C5.1, but Bearded Vulture <i>Gypaetus barbatus</i> may become eligible in the - future, if the European population becomes self-sustaining and vagrants derived from this population appear in Britain.

C5.2	Vagrant from naturalized population – individuals from established naturalized populations outside of Britain that are a result of translocation(s) and that are outside the normal range of the species, e.g. possibly some Ruddy Shelducks <i>Tadorna ferruginea</i> occurring in Britain originating from naturalized populations in near Europe. Currently, Egyptian Goose <i>Alopochen aegyptiacus</i> is the only species in C5.2
C6	Former naturalised species - species formerly placed in C1 whose naturalised populations are either no longer self-sustaining or are considered extinct, e.g. Lady Amherst's Pheasant <i>Chrysolophus amherstiae</i> .
D	Species that would otherwise appear in Category A except that there is reasonable doubt that they have ever occurred in a natural state. Species placed only in Category D form no part of the British List, and are not included in the species totals.

Some are placed in multiple categories such as, for example, those species occurring in Category A which now also have

naturalised populations (e.g. Red Kite) that match Category C criteria. Species in Categories E and F are currently not included on this list.

Other categories

I – a Category A species recorded in Ireland but not in Britain.

X – a globally extinct species.

† – species on the British List for which records are considered by BBRC.
